## 3. Endurance races for 40 km - CEN40 open competition

Prizes: token prizes, ribbons

**Start:** individually or in pairs for 5 minutes

#### Housing:

On the basis of applications EUR 40 (including the first straw installation)

Processing of manure EUR 20 (if the box is not cleaned before leaving)

Hay EUR 5 (6-8 kg bales)

All horses must be stabled in the boxes no later than October 20, 2023 at 4:00 p.m.!

#### Entry fee:

**CEN 80 = 90 euros** 

**CEN 60 = 70 euros** 

CEN 40 = 50 euros

Foreign competitors must pay a guest fee of 11€/rider + 11€/horse.

It does not apply to competitors and horses registrated in Austria, Hungary,

Croatia, Czech Republic, Slovenia, Georgia!!!

#### Riders and horses must have a valid license for 2023!

All foreign competitors and horses are required to submit, together with their entries, a confirmation from their federations for a specific category and their NF has no objections to the start ( NOL- no objections letter)!!!

## **Veterinary conditions:**

Examination for infectious anemia in horses not older than 12 months, with the result recorded in the passport

horse, vaccination against equine influenza according to the valid vaccination scheme – check before unloading the horses at the race office.

Weight limit: unlimited

#### 07:30 a.m. Start of competition No. 2 CEN60

three circuits: 20, 20 and 20 km; mandatory breaks: 40, 40 min.

veterinary closure 64 beats within 20 minutes, at the finish line within 30 minutes min. pace of 10 km/h

The competition is evaluated according to articles 820, 821, and 822 of the Endurance Rules, without penalty.

Weight limit: unlimited

#### 08:00 a.m. Start of competition No. 3 CEN40

two circuits: 20 and 20 km, with a mandatory break of 40 min.

veterinary closure 64 beats within 20 minutes, at the finish line within 30 minutes min. pace 10 km/h, max. pace 16 km/h\*

Both circuits: min. 1h. 15min., max. 2h.00min.

Weight limit: unlimited

#### **GUIDELINES!**

Due to the new rules regarding the fulfilment of the conditions of the novitiate and changes in the calculation of the average speed, the following guidelines for the organisation of national competitions APPLY:

In principle, the unchanged rules for the organisation of national competitions in endurance riding have been valid since 2013. However, due to the above-mentioned changes in the FEI rules for endurance, international rules must also be observed in national competitions (especially in qualifying competitions).

# This is the calculation of the average speed in individual laps as well as in the race as a whole. (Art. 838, FEI endurance rules)

Basically, it is a calculation of the speed from the net driving time on the bike, which does not include the so-called recovery time. Similar to how it was until now when calculating the speed in the last lap of the race. In the FEI rules, from July 1, 2020, the maximum entry time to the veterinary clinic was also changed to 15 minutes after individual rounds and to 20 minutes after arriving at the finish line. It is not yet necessary to change the maximum presentation time in national competitions. However, the average speed must be calculated from the net time on the track, and racers who need to meet the conditions of the novitiate and maintain a speed lower than 16 km/h must be aware of this fact and also count on the fact that the speed. The speed of 16 km/h must not be exceeded in any round. This new rule about observing the average speed must also be applied in national competitions in the ZL category (40–59 km), which are run in Slovakia at a limited speed of 10–16 km/h. It must be calculated as I have already mentioned several times with the clear time on the track and not included in calculations and time for the so-called recovery RECOVERY TIME!!
